

Code of Ethics of the students of the Federal State Autonomous Educational Establishment of Higher Education «Crimean Federal University named after V.I. Vernadsky»

Association of students of the Federal State Autonomous Educational Establishment of Higher Education «Crimean Federal University named after V.I. Vernadsky» (hereinafter referred to as University) understanding that membership in the leading University of the Crimean Federal District requires compliance with high standards of professionalism and moral good conduct, and conscious of its responsibility for the present and the future of the University, for the preservation and multiplication of traditions, for the formation and maintenance of the University system of equal relations between students, university's staff and the administration, based on the belief that knowledge should serve humane purposes, and intellectual development of personality combined with its moral advance, adopts this Code of Ethics of University's students (the Code) and promises strictly follow it.

1. General provisions

1.1. This Code is a voluntary agreement of students defining the ethical norms and rules of conduct for students of the University from the time of entrance until the completion of the study at the University.

1.2. The Code of students entirely aims to create the most comfortable conditions of study, a favorable psychological climate for dialogue between the students themselves, with teachers and University's staff.

1.3. This Code applies to every student at the University, regardless of the direction/specialty of training, forms and training courses.

1.4. The Code is developed in accordance with:

- Constitution of the Russian Federation;
- Federal Law dated 29.12.2012 number 273-FL «Education in the Russian Federation»:
- Resolution of the Russian Government dated 29.11.2014 number 2403-p «Approval of the State Youth Policy of the Russian Federation till 2025».
- University Charter, approved by Ministry of Education and Science of the Russian Federation dated 24.09.2014 № 1280 (as amended);
- Local acts of the University.

1.5. Students of the University should comply with the University's Charter, Internal Rules, Hostel Regulations and other local acts of the University.

1.6. Nothing in this Code can be interpreted as giving someone the right to take actions, fundamental ethical principles and norms or tower above them.

2. Ethical standards of students' behavior at the University.

2.1. Community of students of the University is committed to combat all forms of academic dishonesty, including:

2.1.1. Cribbing and passing exams by fictitious person.

2.1.2. Presentation of ready-learning materials (abstracts, yearly projects, written tests, diploma thesis etc.) as a result of their labor.

2.1.3. Using the familial or official ties to obtain a higher score, or to achieve other advantages over other students.

2.1.4. Cheating teacher and disrespect to him.

2.1.5. To forge documents which are directly or indirectly related to the training of University.

2.1.6. Absence and coming late, missing training sessions or part of them without reasonable excuse.

Association of students deals with all of these types of academic dishonesty as incompatible with access to high-quality and competitive education, a decent future economic, political and administrative elite of Russia.

2.2. Students of University consider unacceptable for themselves:

2.2.1. Using, production and distribution of any drug substances.

2.2.2. Using of obscene and abusive words and expressions of speech.

2.2.3. Smoking on the territory of the Hostel.

2.2.4. Using of alcohol drinks and being in a drunken state on the territory of the University.

2.2.5. Failure to comply with accepted norms of morality and ethics, including the reprehensible behavior in public places.

2.2.6. The crudeness and rudeness towards the students, teachers and staff of the University.

2.2.7. Various forms of public expression of aggression.

2.2.8. Violation of freedom of movement, expression, assembly.

2.2.9. Illegal carrying or possession of a weapon, explosive substances.

2.2.10. Implementation of commercial activities on the territory of the University.

2.3. Students suppose illegal actions and consider unacceptable:

2.3.1. Careless attitude to material and other funds of the University.

2.3.2. Carrying out without permission some equipment, manuals, literature and other University's property from classrooms, laboratories, offices, educational buildings and business premises.

2.3.3. Vandalism (voluntary damage or destruction of University's property).

2.4. Students should adhere to the neatness, tidiness, business style of clothing and avoid defiant make-up.

2.5. Students should lead a healthy and active lifestyle.

2.6. Students should be punctual and come to classes on time.

2.7. Students should perform all the necessary teacher's requirements for the educational process. Not allowed actions that are impeding the realization of classes and creating inconvenience to acquire knowledge by others, such as free movement along the classroom during the class, chatting, including using mobile.

2.8. Students should support an atmosphere of trust and mutual responsibility in the university community.

2.9. Students should treat the University Library and Information Resources with respect and care.

2.10. Students should recognize the necessary and useful activities that are aimed at strengthening the system of student government, development of creative

activity and extracurricular activities (socially useful, scientific and educational, sporting, artistic, etc.).

2.11. Students that undergo practical training in commercial, budgetary or public organizations, state and municipal authorities should be aware that with their behavior they form an impression about the University in general.

2.12. Students at the University scrupulously should abide by local acts of the University.

2.13. Students should economically and efficiently use the material resources of the University.

2.14. In order to maintain order and prevent crime, students are required to show the identification documents to the representative of the guard when entering the building.

3. Responsibility for violation of the provisions the Code

3.1. Administration of the University has the right to apply to violators of this Code the disciplinary sanctions stipulated by the Charter and the Rules of the Internal Labor Regulations of the University.

3.2. Monitoring of compliance with the provisions of this Code lies with the course leader of academic groups, supervising professors of academic groups. They have the right to submit for review by the relevant authorities issues relating to disciplinary sanctions.

3.3. Students that discovered the violation of the provisions of this Code should make an attempt to stop it in the limits of existing legislation, and if this is not possible, student government or the administration of the structural unit (branch) of the University announces about the violator.

3.4. Community of students has the right to establish on their own initiative ethical commission which has the power to analyze cases of violations and to make penalties, including apply for the University administration for the application of disciplinary action against offenders, in accordance with local acts of the University.

3.5. To resolve the dispute, the disciplinary commission may be established at the University. The basic composition of the disciplinary commission shall include a representative of the Council of students, representative of the primary trade union organization of students FSAEE HE «V.I. Vernadsky CFU», representatives of the administration of the structural unit (branch) and the University administration. The composition of the disciplinary commission may include other persons, based on the decision of the basic structure of the commission, if it is necessary to deal with specific cases of violation of the provisions of this Code.

4. Final provisions

4.1. This Code is approved by the Rector of the University and enters into force from the date of its adoption. Changes and amendments to this Code are made according to the established manner of the University.
