## Type of practical training: assistent to a physical at the in-patient medical department (therapy)

## The list of compulsory practical skills and knowledge:

- 1. Management of patients
- 2. Filling in case histories (including those while on duty)
- 3. Composing and grounding a plan of investigations for a patient
- 4. Making differential diagnosis, grounding and formulating of a final clinical diagnosis:
- the main disease;
- complications;
- associate conditions
- 5. Diagnosis and rendering emergency care (attack of bronchial asthma and status asthmaticus, fainting, angina pectoris, hypertensive crisis, renal and biliary colics, diabetic coma, hypoglycaemia, anaphylactic shock, etc.)
- 6. External cardiac massage and artificial respiration
- 7. Hygienic requirements while working at a medical department
- 8. Intravenous injections
- 9. Intravenous infusion of solutions
- 10. Determining a blood group and making an Rh-incompatibility test
- 11. Observing blood transfusion
- 12. Taking ECG, PCG and echocardiography on one's own
- 13. Deciphering ECG, PCG and echocardiography
- 14. Estimating radiological findings
- 15. Estimating laboratory findings (clinical, biochemical tests, liver and kidney function tests)
- 16. Participation in pleural and abdominal punctures
- 17. Taking blood pressure
- 18. Observing autopsy examinations
- 19. Participation in communication of autopsy results
- 20. Observing endoscopic investigations (bronchoscopy, gastroduodenoscopy)
- 21. Observing abdominal, cardiac and renal ultrasound
- 22. Urinary catheterisation 23. Gastric and duodenal intubation
- 24. Gastric lavage
- 25. Filling in a discharge summary for patients managed by a student
- 26. Writing out sick-leaves, referrals to commissions of experts, sanatorium cards .
