### **Type of practical training: Assistent of an obstatrican and ginecologian at the in-patient department**

#### **The list of compulsory practical skills and knowledge**

1. Inspection and external examination of pregnant women.
2. Filling in case histories of labour.
3. Vaginal examination during labour.
4. Rupture of the amniotic sack.
5. Non-breached delivery and inspection of the birth canal.
6. Examination of the placenta and determining its integrity.
7. Suturing ruptures of the perineal of the 1 and 2 degree, the walls of the vagina, cervix (under doctors supervision).
8. The first inspection of the newborn, umbilical cord.
9. Determination of the blood groups.
10. Catheterization of the bladder with the rubber or metal catheter
11. Participation in the resuscitation of neonate.
12. Participation in the obstetric operations: C- section (if available), manual interventions in case of the breach delivery, application of the obstetrics forceps.
13. Sanitation requirements for the delivery room.
14. Epidemiological events during childbirth and postpartum women with HIV In the postpartum unit.
15. Observation of the puerperas.
16. Hygiene of the puerperas.
17. Taking smears from three points to determine the flora
18. Intramuscular and subcutaneous injections.
19. Hygiene of the stitches of the perineum.
20. Hygienic determination of the nutritional value of food in the postpartum period.
21. Intravenous injection.
22. Participation in the operation of medical abortion.
23. Participation in the anesthesia and resuscitation procedures.
24. Carrying out paracervical novocaine anesthesia.
25. Sutures removal from the anterior abdominal wall and perineum
26. Health education (discussions, medical information).
27. Criteria for assessing microbiological purity of the air in hospitals.
