

## Skills Diagnostic practice

Communicates professionally with patients, junior and secondary medical personnel, and the medical staff of a medical organization.
Conducts a patient survey - can identify the main complaints, find out the history of the disease and the patient's life history.
Demonstrates the skill of conducting a visual examination of the patient.
Demonstrates the skill of determining the patient's condition.
Demonstrates the skill of conducting anthropometric research.
Demonstrates the skill of measuring blood pressure, heart rate, BH, thermometry, pulse oximetry.
Demonstrates the skill of performing spirometry.
Demonstrates the skill of taking an ECG.
Demonstrates the skill of collecting tests: blood, urine, feces, sputum.
Demonstrates the skill of installing a Holter monitor and/or a SMAD device.
Demonstrates the skill of performing general palpation of the patient.
Demonstrates the skill of performing abdominal percussion without defining the boundaries of organs.
Demonstrates the skill of performing abdominal auscultation.
Demonstrates the skill of detecting the presence of edema.
Fills out medical documentation used in surgical and therapeutic departments (temperature sheet, consents for medical research and manipulation, journals, blood collection for research, etc.)
Fills out forms for blood and urine tests, referrals for research.
